A Note from the Pastor...

A couple weeks ago, I told you about a ministry opportunity that had been offered to our church. This ministry opportunity was directed toward serving caregivers of those with Dementia and Alzheimer's. Today, I am thrilled to tell you that we had an overwhelming response. Several people volunteered to be trained and to facilitate this group. Thank you to everyone who responded. Instances like this prove that God is at work in the hearts of His people, preparing them for ministry and presenting opportunities to serve.

At the same time, we are beginning an American Sign Language class on Sunday nights starting August 13th. This class is the result of one member who has the passion and skill to lead this class being willing to be used by God. As of Monday morning, we have almost 40 people signed up for this class, and 95% of the people registered do not attend our church. That means we will make contact with 35 families who may or may not have a church home through this class.

Please pray for these two ministries. Specifically, pray that God will use these acts of love to touch the participants and draw them to the gospel. You may not be drawn to either of these two ministries, but there is something for you to do. If you have a ministry idea in your mind or on your heart, please let someone know so we can help you get started.

If you are looking for something to do, I may have a ministry for you. As school begins, I am reminded that on the days when it rains our teachers stand in the rain before and after school helping children in and out of the cars. I've worked in the rain before, and it is not a pleasant way to start your day. I wonder if we have 5-15 people in our church who would be willing to volunteer with me to work in the place of those teachers on the days that it rains? If you are willing to help, please let me know this week so I can add you to my contact list.

There are so many good things happening at PRBC. God is truly at work and I am excited to see what He is going to do next. I look forward to seeing you next Sunday.
