

# Quarantine Week 2—Family Worship Guide



## Pray

Pray that your family will find opportunities to meet regularly to worship together.

Pray that Christ will be most glorified through your family's worship, reading of Scripture, and discussion(s).

Pray for the nation during our quarantine. (Specifically pray for medical professionals and the anxiety they face on a daily basis)

Pray for opportunities to call and video chat with other members of the church.

<sup>4</sup>Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. <sup>5</sup>You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. <sup>6</sup>And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. <sup>7</sup>You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and

when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. <sup>8</sup>You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. <sup>9</sup>You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.”

—Deuteronomy 6:4–9 (English Standard Version)

- How can your family “love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might...”?
- What are some creative way that your family can regularly teach each other God's Word this week?
- What time of the day is best for you and your family to meet regularly together this week?
- In light of the current Covid-19 pandemic, how can this passage cause you and your family to love the Lord your God better this week than last week?
- How can each member of your family loving teach each other God's Words?
- What are some questions that you have from Deuteronomy 6?
