## Discuss

- Read Hebrews 2:17-3:12. How does Hebrews 2:17-3:12 inform your understanding of Jesus as “a great high priest”?
- How is Jesus being a “great high priest” connected to the redemption of sinners?
- What are some weaknesses that you (and your family) have struggled with during the Covid-19 pandemic?
- Looking back on the New Testament, what are some ways that Jesus has sympathized with you (and your families) weaknesses?
- What are some ways that you have experienced or witnessed God's grace (in the world or in your personal life)?
- How can you (and your family) take confidence in and draw near to God's grace?
- How can you (and your family) live differently knowing the central truths of Hebrews 4:14-16?
